I strongly believe that Ohio is going down the right path by pursuing election reform. However, H.B. 3/S.B. 3 in its current format does not go far enough in enacting the necessary changes that will make Ohio a leader in election reform throughout the country. While considering H.B. 3/S.B. 3, I hope you will consider the following changes:

- Allow provisional voting to occur anywhere in the registered voter's proper county, as was intended by the Help America Vote Act;
- Include recount procedures that are fair to voters and boards of election and provide for a recount to be completed before Electors must cast their votes;
- Prohibit non-elected election administrators from participating in partisan political campaigns and elected officials to be limited to participation in their own campaigns;
- Allow counties to have choice in their voting machines and preserve the VVPAT requirement that the rest of the country is just now realizing is a necessary and critical component of election reform;
- Provide the option of no-excuse absentee voting;
- Make all voting polling places accessible;
- Create easy-to-use systems and procedures to help voters find their proper polling places and precincts without waiting in long lines;
- Remove challengers from the polls on Election Day.

Thank you for considering my concerns and suggestions and working to craft comprehensive election reform that all Ohioans deserve.
